

## GENERAL ELECTION PROCLAMATION

The County Board of Elections of Cameron County do by this means give notice in accordance with the provisions of Section 106 of this Act approved May 16, 1929, the Legal Newspaper Act of September 29, 1951, by the provisions of the Election Code. The offices to be elected, the places at which the election is to be held in the various election districts of the County and the hours the polls will be open.

The 2020 General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020. The polls will open at 7:00 A.M. and will close at 8:00 P.M.

In the Matter of Pre-Canvassing of the absentee and mail-in ballots, the Cameron County Election Board will convene at 9:00AM on Tuesday, November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2020 in the Commissioner Office/Conference Room of the Cameron County Courthouse. One authorized representative of each candidate in an election and one representative from each political party (Watcher's) shall be permitted to remain in the room in which the absentee ballots and mail-in ballots are pre-canvassed. CDC guidelines will be followed during the canvass. Applications for Watcher Certificates must be received by Thursday, October 29<sup>th</sup> at 4:00PM by the Board of Elections for both pre-canvassing and poll-watchers.

IN THE MATTER OF OFFICIAL COMPUTATIONS AND RE-CANVASSING OF THE VOTES CAST AT THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON THE 3<sup>rd</sup> DAY OF NOVEMBER, 2020 IN THE SEVERAL ELECTION DISTRICTS OF THE COUNTY OF CAMERON, PENNSYLVANIA. This shall commence on Friday, November 6, 2020 at 9:00 AM, prevailing time to compute and canvass the election returns.

Eligibility of any military or overseas ballots received after the deadline of 5:00 P.M. on the seventh day following the election will be determined on Thursday, November 12, 2020.
